

It is also the model relationship that God maintained with Jesus and it's the type of relationship that God, our Heavenly Father, desires to have with each one of us

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Our theory is that when kids can connect with their parents on an intimate level, they won't go searching for it from other people

So we believe the first piece in instilling Sexual integrity in the lives of your children is:

Intentionally equipping your children with intimate relationships at home

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We are all on this search for intimacy but the danger is when we fall for the counterfeit. True intimacy is built over time and takes years to build



There is no way to get intimacy outside of the way God designed it

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By engaging with our children, intimately knowing them and loving them, we can alter the course of their lives and keep them from making the mistake of having premarital sex and damaging their bodies and souls

How God views sex versus how we view sex

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Besides culture, we also learn to think about sex from our parents

To teach sexual integrity to your kids, you need to have a healthy view on sex

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The truth is that God created sex as a good thing to be enjoyed between a husband and wife and God doesn't make mistakes

Sex between a husband and wife symbolizes that future marriage between Christ and the Church

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Sexuality is a function of not just our body, but our mind and spirit as <u>well</u>



There is no room at all for pornography in the life and home of a believer

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When we teach our kids about sex from God's perspective, they can experience the fullness and beauty of a sexual relationship like it was intended to be, without the baggage of regret or shame

As parents, we have the power and influence in our children's lives to encourage purity

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It's our job to teach them, grow them, and prepare them for a day when they will need to be responsible for themselves

If you want to do your best to protect and prepare your children for living in the real world, we have to talk to them about the tough stuff

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Start young with your kids and give them age appropriate details





Keep in mind that when you tell your kids about sex, you are not taking away their innocence, you are helping them understand that it is a beautiful and natural gift that God created

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If you wait to tell them, it will come from the world, and the world will paint a much different picture

The key is for you to be the one to tell them, not someone else

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Sex talks should be often and both spontaneous and planned

Don't let the fear of your past keep you from talking to your kids

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Purity is more than the physical. It's a mindset to strive to live life God's way; to walk with Him



Trying to instill purity in our kids is trying to inspire them to return God's love with a lifestyle that is obedient and loving to Him. While he created those desires, He created them for the right time

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Physical contact creates emotional and spiritual bonds. Those bonds are meant to be shared with only one person

Understand that the goal is much more than just not having sex. The real goal is purity

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Consistently affirming our passionate understanding of their priceless worth based on God's unfailing love for them. We must feed our kids' self worth with who they are in Christ

Culture has a profound effect on all of our thinking

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We teach our daughters to see themselves as God sees them -beautiful, desired, and cherished. We must teach our sons to be strong and brave, standing up against culture's lies so that instead of pressuring young ladies, these young men are respecting and cherishing them, safeguarding sexuality

When our children know God and understand how much He loves them, it should change the way they live and what they value

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We need our kids to understand that their security and worth come from God and the fact that he took the time to create each one of us with care and purpose

We have to love God more than anything and teach our children to do the same. When they love God more than their own desire for pleasure or what other people think of them, they'll be better equipped to take a stand and keep themselves pure

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Keeping our children on a path to sexual purity is not easy or guaranteed, but we can do our best at defying the odds when we consistently develop loving, intimate relationships with them, teach them how to view sex from God's perspective, make the most out of our time and influence with them, and show them that their identity and value is rooted in God
