A MESSAGE FROM OUR SENIOR PASTOR

Dear Brookwood Family,

uring this past year, we have demonstrated *Love in Action* within our church, our community and in the world. As you review this year's Ministry Plan, you will discover the many ways we Love God and Love People through the ministries of our church.

Our proposed budget of \$7,600,021 is \$76,021 more than last year (a 1% increase). Signs of growth include a 5% increase in giving over the previous year and 709 people giving for the first time. In addition, we sold two tracts of excess land, reducing our total debt to below \$800,000. With continued generosity among our church family, we can be debt free by next summer!

We have spent over a million dollars in India to care for over 800 children and to buy, prepare, and fence land for a home for them. In the coming year, we will continue to care for the children and also begin construction. We have also spent \$236,000 in Africa, South America, the Caribbean islands and in the US, supporting missionaries, sponsoring mission trips and participating in disaster relief.

We will continue our international endeavors next year and increase our support for local projects such as benevolence, disaster relief, food ministry, home repairs, ServeFest and monthly community volunteering by 47%.



We have been learning about God's character and listening for His voice. We will focus on knowing Him through His Word. We will read and study *The Story*, an abridged version of the Bible, arranged chronologically over 31 chapters as one continuous story of God and His people. The lessons will be preached and taught to our entire church family on Sunday mornings. Small Groups will review what they are learning during the week. My hope is that every one of us will read each week's chapter, attend Sunday services, get involved in a Small Group and discuss what we are learning with our families.

Let this be the year that you determine to grow spiritually, give generously and serve willingly. Give this year to God and let Him change your life! LET THIS BE THE YEAR THAT YOU DETERMINE TO GROW SPIRITUALLY, GIVE GENEROUSLY AND SERVE WILLINGLY. GIVE THIS YEAR TO GOD AND LET HIM CHANGE YOUR LIFE!

MORE CHILD SLAVES TO BE RELEASED

Before any of the slave children were released, Praveen had been witnessing to one of the guarry owners for years. Recently the man died and the family called Praveen to come see them. The man had written Praveen a letter before he died telling of turning to Christ and the peace he experienced. Then the family warned Praveen about the anger of many quarry owners and their plans to kill him. They also disclosed information about the location of seven more guarries where children were enslaved. In the power of the Holy Spirit Praveen visited those quarries and was actually welcomed by those who had opposed him before! Many asked Praveen to pray for them. Praveen and several pastors with him gathered information from the children so attempts could be made to locate their parents. The plan is to care for the children in village churches near where the parents live. Pray for protection for Praveen and the pastors who will rescue these children and the means to carry out their work.



BECAUSE OF YOUR GENEROSITY...

In India

- 800 rescued and abandoned children are receiving love and guidance, a secure home environment, medical care, basic education, and age appropriate vocational training.
- A campus is under construction on six acres near Kakinada.
- 50 older girls have been trained to sew and now are working in a Bangalore shirt factory under the watch care of local pastors' wives.
- Praveen is planning to liberate several hundred more children who are still slaves in rock quarries.

Around the World

- Over 30,000 new believers have been baptized by our mission partners.
- 498 new churches have been started in West Africa and India in five years.
- Dennis Aggrey trained 225 pastors who started 226 new churches in Liberia.
- Rick and Laura Leatherwood provided audio Bibles for 15 unreached tribes who will learn of Jesus and the scriptures and disciple many more in remote Ethiopia.
- Dr. Dean and Dr. Deanna Kubacz will begin their medical ministry in a mission hospital in Chad (Central Africa).
- Water of Life drilled water wells that helped to start new churches.
- 119 people have gone on mission trips to serve and encourage our mission partners.

STORY OF LIFE CHANGE

"I came from a home where both my parents were atheists. I never had a place where I felt I could discuss openly about God, and the MILE classes gave me the perfect opportunity to do so.
