- Rash with a fever or behavior change Child may return with a rash after being fever free for 24 hours without the aid of a fever reducing medication.

Pink Eye or conjunctivitis

Child may return after first dose of medication.

□ Strep Throat

Child may return 24 hours after first dose of medication and fever free for 24 hours without the aid of a fever reducing medication.

□ Croup

Child may return to school after being fever free for 24 hours without the aid of a fever reducing medication.

D RSV

Child may return to school after being fever free for 24 hours without the aid of a fever reducing medication.

Hand, foot and mouth disease Child may return to school after being fever free for 24 hours without the aid of a fever reducing medication. The blisters should be dry and crusted over.

Staph infection/MRSA

May return after being on antibiotics for 24 hours and with the site covered.

□ Ringworm

Child may return with a doctor's note documenting diagnosis and initiation of anti-fungal therapy.

Mouth sores

Child may return when no mouth sores are present, unless the child's doctor states that the child is not contagious.

🗆 Flu

Child may return to school after being fever free for 24 hours without the aid of a fever reducing medication.

Head lice

Child may return 24 hours after a treatment and has no signs of lice or eggs.

Scabies, pinworm, or other infections May return with a doctor's note.

Tuberculosis

May return with a doctor's note.
