Conversation Starter

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read Philippians 2:6-11.

- 1. How would you summarize vs. 9-11?
- 2. What does it mean that Jesus was *given the name above all other names*? Why is that important?
- 3. What motivation does Paul give us in this passage for living a life of love and service to others? *See also*: 1 John 4:7-21.
- 4. What do these passages say about God's glory?
 - a) Hebrews 1:1-4
 - b) Psalm 8:1-9
 - c) Revelation 21:22-27
- 5. How does Jesus' sacrifice, not only on the cross, but knowing He surrendered everything to become fully human, affect your life?

- 6. How does Jesus' authority over all creation, knowing that He's fully God, affect your life? *See also*: Matthew 11:27; 28:18-20; John 1:10-13.
- 7. How does the assurance of your salvation in the person and work of Jesus Christ affect your daily living? *See also*: 1 John 5:11-17.
- 8. This week what part of Philippians 2:6-11 brings you the greatest comfort and strength?
- 9. As you reflect on the character of Christ revealed in Philippians 2:6-11, how does it affect your life in terms of your...
 - a) Interactions with others (inside and outside the church)?
 - b) Giving and generosity?
 - c) Priorities (schedule, activities, service)?
 - d) Worship?
