To get you thinking: What causes you to feel weighed down?

Read Revelation 12:7-11.

- 1. What verse or phrase in this passage is most significant to you?
- 2. Why do you think Satan and his angels were thrown out of heaven?
- 3. What was Satan doing to the followers of Jesus?
- 4. Describe a time when you've felt accused by Satan.
- 5. What two key elements caused Satan's defeat?
- 6. How does the blood of the Lamb (Jesus) bring victory? (2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 Peter 1:18-19)
- 7. How does the *word of our testimony* bring victory? (Romans 1:16-17)
- 8. Read John 3:16. How has the claim in this verse affected your life?
- 9. If you've accepted that Jesus paid your death penalty, and you've placed your faith in Jesus, share your faith story in two sentences for each point below:
 - a. Describe your life before trusting Jesus.
 - b. Describe how you came to believe that Jesus died for you and surrendered your life to Him.
 - c. Describe changes in your life since you trusted Jesus.
