DIGGING DEEPER

Dear children, let's not merely say that we love each other; let us show the truth by our actions. **1 John 3:18 (NLT)**

Insight: Everyone needs to be loved, and to receive love. But not everyone feels loved, or receives love, in the same way. One way to show your love to someone is by finding what makes them feel loved and expressing love to them in that way. The relationship displayed in the book of *Song of Songs* in the Bible describes several different expressions of love between a man and a woman.

To get you thinking: What makes you feel loved?

- 7. Read 1 John 3:16. In what ways did Jesus give up His life for you?
- 8. Ask God to show you how He wants you to be an instrument of His love to someone today.
