- 5. Describe when you saw an unbeliever begin to follow Christ. How did that affect you?
- 6. How has your reliance on God changed as we've learned more about faithfulness in the past 5 weeks? What can you do to rely on Him more?
- 7. How does the promise of spending eternity with Jesus strengthen you?
- 8. What are you holding onto that needs to be released to God? Take time to pray and give that to Him.
