Conversation Starter

Name one or two significant transitions in your life.

Opening in Prayer

Spend a few minutes in silence. Ask God to soften your heart so you'd be open to receiving anything He wants to say to you.

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read Exodus 4:18-5:9.

- 1. What major adjustments did Moses need to make in order to join God in His work? See also <u>Isaiah 55:8-9</u>.
- 2. Why did God include circumcision as part of the covenant relationship between Him and His people? For further insight, read Genesis 17:1-14.
- 3. Based on your response to question 2, what's the importance of circumcision in *this* story (vs. 4:24-26)?
- 4. Have you ever made a significant adjustment or decision so you could be more a part of God's work? If so, what change did you make? How did people around you respond to your decision?
- 5. Are there any adjustments or life changes you sense God has been asking you to make, but you've been resistant to follow through on? What has God been asking you to do? Why are you hesitating?

- 6. Moses faced a lot of opposition. He might have been tempted to give up or run away and hide. How did Moses stay focused on the mission?
- 7. What do you do to keep your eyes focused on Jesus? For insight, check out Matthew 6:19-24; 2 Corinthians 4:13-18; Hebrews 12:1-2.
- 8. What success or comfort would you be willing to give up if God invited you to go do something else?
- 9. What steps could you take to impact the world, the church or someone's life this week?

10. What's one of the most significant Scriptures or ideas from this week's teaching?
