What scared you most as a kid?

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read <u>Luke 24:37-40</u> and <u>John 20:19-23</u> (the first four paragraphs of Reading #216 *in The Life of Jesus*).

- 1. What was causing the disciples to experience such fear?
- 2. What did Jesus say and do to change their doubt and fear to belief and amazement?
- 3. Have you ever encountered Jesus in such a way that changed the emotion you were experiencing? If so, describe what that was like.
- 4. Is experiencing peace with God essential for sharing your faith? Why or why not? *See also*: Romans 5:1-5; Ephesians 2:17-18.
- 5. How is our forgiveness of others related to God's forgiveness of us? How does our forgiveness of others help fulfill the mission of the church? See also: Matthew 16:19; Luke 7:47-50.

Read <u>John 20:24-29</u> (continue Reading #216, then finish with #217 in *The Life of Jesus*).

6. What were the disciples feeling as they spoke with Thomas? Have you ever felt like that? If so, explain.

- 7. What does Jesus mean by the statement in <u>John 20:29</u>? See also: 2 Corinthians 5:7; 1 Peter 1:8-9
- 8. What are signs someone has faith in Jesus?
- 9. What is the most significant part of this week's teaching for you? How is God leading you to respond?
