Read John 8:12 (The first verse of Reading #111 in The Life of Jesus).

- 1. What does it mean that Jesus is the light of the world?
- 2. What can we learn about God and light from these passages?
 - a. <u>Exodus 13:21-22</u>
 - b. <u>Isaiah 60:1-3</u>
 - c. <u>Psalm 36:9</u>
 - d. Psalm 43:3
 - e. 1 John 1:5-7
- 3. Have you ever experienced Jesus as light? Describe.
- 4. What do these passages teach about darkness?
 - a. Proverbs 4:18-19
 - b. Matthew 6:22-23
 - c. Acts 26:15-18
 - d. Romans 13:11-14
 - e. <u>Ephesians 5:8-14</u>
- 5. Can you think of ways you've walked in darkness? Describe.
- 6. How would you describe a person who has the light of life?

Jump ahead to John 8:30-37 (The middle of Reading #111 in *The Life of Jesus*).

- 7. What does Jesus mean by *continue in My word*? If someone asked you how to do that, what would you say? What does that process look like?
- 8. How does knowing the truth set us free? What does Jesus want to free us from? *See also* Romans 6:5-8; 12-18.
- 9. How would your life be different if you were experiencing greater freedom in Christ?
- 10. How does a slave experience life differently than a son or daughter? See also Galatians 4:1-7.
- 11. How would you summarize the truth of <u>John 8:30-37</u>?
- 12. What is God saying to you personally from this week's teaching?
