- 2. What word or phrase would you use to describe Mary's attitude during the conversation with the angel?
- 3. What step(s) would better prepare you to listen for a message from God?

#### **Read <u>Luke 2:1-7</u>**

- 4. Why do you think Joseph and Mary had difficulty finding a place to stay in Bethlehem?
- 5. What would you do if a pregnant relative showed up at your house needing a place to stay?

- 6. How do you think Joseph and Mary ended up staying in a place where there was a manger (a feeding trough for animals)?
- 7. What might have been different if the people of Bethlehem knew that Mary's baby was the Son of God?
- 8. What causes you to forget the presence of Jesus in your daily life?
- 9. What can you do to make room for Jesus during this Christmas season?
