## **Personal Reflection/Group Discussion**

**Read Matthew 23:1-8** (The beginning of Reading #169 in *The Life of Jesus*).

1. What was wrong with the way the scribes and Pharisees acted? What is Jesus trying to help us avoid?

#### Note on Matthew 23:5

Phylacteries were small boxes containing Scripture strapped to the right arm and forehead in obedience to <u>Deuteronomy 6:6-8</u>. Apparently the Pharisees had made the straps extra-wide to make them more visible, and made the tassels on their prayer shawls (<u>Numbers 15:38</u>) extra-long in order to be seen.

- 2. When have you pretended to be more spiritual than you really are?
- 3. Why are we so concerned about what others think of us?
- 4. What character traits make someone trustworthy to you?

**Read Matthew 23:9-12** (continuing Reading #169 in *The Life of Jesus*).

- 5. How would you describe someone who is humble?
- 6. What is one thing you can do to humble yourself?

In the last part of **Reading #169 in The Life of Jesus (Matthew 23:13-36)**, Jesus pronounces several prophetic *woes* (very harsh warnings or judgments) on the scribes and Pharisees. Rather than helping God's people come to know the love and amazing grace of God, these religious leaders abused their power and position of authority by oppressing others. They were guilty of *going through the motions*, but their hearts were far from God (*See Isaiah 29:13; Matthew 15:8*).

**Carefully study Jesus' accusations**. Instead of focusing on what you shouldn't do, ask God to help you understand ways He wants you to live as a follower of Christ.
