Luke 22:14-20

- 1. How would you feel if Jesus told you He was excited to share this meal with you? Why would you feel that way?
- 2. When Jesus said, "Do this in remembrance of Me." He was asking the disciples to continue the practice of the Lord's Supper even after He was gone. Why?
