Discussion Guide

Use this guide to help you draw closer to God. Try not to rush through these questions, but take time to learn and grow. Ask God to speak to you in His Word. Find a Small Group at brookwoodchurch.org/smallgroups.

Conversation Starter

What is the least expected (or most surprising) event that has happened to you? Would there have been any way for you to foresee it?

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read Matthew 24:1-14 (The beginning of Reading #171 in *The Life of Jesus*).

- 1. This chapter describes events that would happen while the disciples were still alive, but also points to the end of the world (vs. 3, 6, 13-14). What specific signs does Jesus name that reveal the end is near? What are modern-day examples of each of these signs?
- 2. What dangers accompany Jesus' appearing?
- 3. How often do you think about the end of the world or the second coming of Jesus? *Explain*.
- 4. If someone asked you why there's so much violence and hatred in the world, how do you think God would want you to respond? What Bible verses help you interpret the times we live in?
- 5. How can Christians keep their love from growing cold?

Jump ahead to Matthew 24:36-44.

6. Rather than speculating the specific day and time Jesus will return, He simply tells us to *be alert* (NLT has *keep watch*). How does Jesus want us to live in light of His return? What does it mean to *be alert*? Rather than watching world events, what does Jesus want us to watch?

- 7. Identify one or two of the most important insights God is drawing your attention to in this passage. What does He want you to remember?
- 8. In your own words, what is the good news of Jesus?
- 9. What areas of your life, in light of eternity, are probably pretty pointless and a waste of time?

10.In light of this week's teaching, what is a great action step for you? *See also*: 1 Thessalonians 4:13-5:11.
