## **Personal Reflection/Group Discussion**

### Read Matthew 2:1-8.

- 1. Why do you think Herod was disturbed to hear that the wise men were looking for a *newborn king of the Jews*?
- 2. Why do you think the people of Jerusalem were disturbed when they heard about a *newborn king of the Jews*?
- 3. How do you think Herod got the idea that this new baby might be the *Messiah*? (vs. 4)

#### Read Matthew 2:13-18.

- 4. Why do you think Herod wanted to kill the child who was potentially the Messiah? (vs. 13, 16)
- 5. How did Herod's desire to kill the child affect others?

- 6. The Messiah has been born and wants to give you real life by becoming the King of your life.
  - a. How might someone be threatened by that news?
  - b. Why might someone be thankful for that news?
  - c. How does that news affect you?

Ask God to point out something that you're holding back from Him. Confess that and release control to Him.
