What part do you play in preparing your Thanksgiving meal?

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read <u>Luke 22:7-27</u>.

- 1. What was Jesus' role in the preparations for this Passover meal? What role did the disciples play?
- 2. How would you feel if you were one of the disciples who saw that everything was prepared as Jesus said?
- 3. What is a key step for preparing to spend time with Jesus?
- 4. Why was Jesus eager to share this Passover with His disciples? (vs. 15)
- 5. What did Jesus mean when He said, "This is My body, which is given for you."? (vs. 19)

- 6. What do you think Jesus wants us to remember about Him? (vs. 19)
- 7. What does the dispute among the disciples indicate about what they valued? (vs 24)
- 8. What does Jesus' reply indicate that He values? How does this affect you?
- 9. If Jesus were serving the Lord's Supper to you, how would you express your gratitude?
