

We also offer our Special Friends Ministry designed for children with special needs which meets in Pod B of our BrookwoodKiDs area. The Nursing Mothers Room, located at the North Tunnel, is available for our nursing mothers who would like to view the service and nurse their child in private. The Pod A Parent Lounge is available for the occasional times parents may feel the need to watch the service with their child.
