Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

THE CHARACTER OF THOSE IN THE KINGDOM

Read Matthew 5:1-12 (This is the first part of Reading #54 in *The Life of Jesus*, which also includes verses from Luke 6:17-26).

- 1. Name the character traits mentioned in this passage.
- 2. How can each of these qualities draw us closer to God?
- 3. Think of someone you know who *hungers and thirsts for righteousness*. What are the distinguishing marks in that person's life?
- 4. How do the character traits in this passage differ from the values of the world? Identify specific ways followers of Christ are supposed to be different than the world.

THE INFLUENCE OF THOSE IN THE KINGDOM

Read Matthew 5:13 (continuing Reading #54 in The Life of Jesus).

- 5. What does it mean to be *the salt of the earth*? (Hint: Think of the various uses of salt, then consider ways God calls His people to be like that.) *See also*: 2 Kings 2:20-21; Job 6:6; Mark 9:50; Colossians 4:5-6.
- 6. What makes a person less salty?

Read Matthew 5:14-16 (continuing Reading #54 in *The Life of Jesus*).

- 7. What are practical examples of what it means to be the light of the world? I am being a light when ______.

 See also: Ephesians 5:8-9; 2 Corinthians 4:1-6; 1 John 2:7-11.
- 8. What point is Jesus making in vs. 14-15?
- 9. Spend a few minutes in stillness and silence. What part of this week's lesson is God speaking to you about? What do you hear Him saying? How will you respond?

Soul Training

Write the words *salt and light* on an index card. Put this somewhere you will see it often. Each time you see this, ask God to fill you with His light and His love. Ask Him to reveal specific people and specific ways you can be salt and light. Use this time to help you *intentionally influence others toward Jesus*.
