Describe a time you took a huge step of faith.

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read Matthew 11:1-3 (This is the first part of Reading #57 in The Life of Jesus).

- 1. Who was John? See also Mark 1:1-8.
- 2. Are you surprised he was in prison? What does the text lead you to believe he was feeling?
- 3. Which specific beatitudes (*from last week's message*, Matthew 5:3-12) are being displayed in John's life?
- 4. Have you ever done what you thought God wanted you to do, but it didn't turn out like you expected? How did you respond? Explain.
- 5. How can times of doubt and disappointment deepen your relationship with God?

Read Matthew 11:4-11 (continuing Reading #57 in The Life of Jesus).

- 6. What miraculous (big, bold, kingdom-size) things have you been asking from Jesus recently?
- 7. Do you live with great anticipation for God to come through, or are you holding back, not sure He has the best in mind for you? Where is your heart with God these days?

Read Matthew 11:12-19 (continuing Reading #57 in The Life of Jesus).

- Most people reject God because He doesn't meet their expectations.
 As this part of the story describes, these unmet expectations often cause people to become demanding, confused, disheartened or angry.
 Can you relate to any of this? Explain.
- 9. How would your life be different if you believed more fully all the Bible says about God?
- 10. What can you do to prepare your heart and mind ahead of time for trials and disappointments that will inevitably come your way?

Soul Training

On a note card, write down five things that are true about God from Psalm 99. Use this list to guide a time of prayer each day this week:

1) Tell God how awesome He is, and 2) ask Him to help you know Him more intimately based on who He truly is.
