Discussion Guide

Use this guide to help you pursue a relationship with Jesus. Talk with God as you work your way through these thoughts and questions. Be attentive to what He is saying and how He is leading.

Conversation Starter

Describe a time someone came alongside and helped you.

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read John 9:1-12 (The beginning of Reading #112 in The Life of Jesus).

- 1. Why do you think the disciples concluded the man's blindness was the result of sin? What does this reveal about their view of God? What does this reveal about how they looked at people?
- 2. In simple terms, what does Jesus say is the reason for the man's blindness? What is your response to that explanation?
- 3. Was there any particular purpose for Jesus healing with dirt and spit?
- 4. How did neighbors and friends respond? Why weren't they more excited?

Read John 9:13-34 (continuing Reading #112 in The Life of Jesus).

- 5. Why were the Pharisees so unwilling to accept that Jesus came from God? (vs. 34 sheds light on this. See also John 3:19-21; Revelation 3:15-19)
- 6. What are signs someone is full of spiritual pride?
- 7. Why were the parents afraid?
- 8. Have you ever been hesitant or afraid to share your beliefs about Jesus? Describe the situation. Why were you afraid?

Read John 9:35-41 (continuing Reading #112 in *The Life of Jesus*).

- 9. Why do you think the man believes, yet the Pharisees remain unbelieving? What made the difference? What might be needed, then, for your own faith to grow?
- 10. The man believed and responded in worship (vs. 38). What does true worship look like and feel like?
- 11. How would you summarize John 9:39-41? See also 1 John 1:5-10.
- 12. What part of this study do you feel is most important for you right now?
