Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

- 1. List several ways men and women are different based on Genesis 2:21-23.
- 2. How do you see these differences playing out in your relationships?
- 3. What do the following verses teach us about the purpose of sex and God's intention for physical intimacy?
 - a. Genesis 1:28; 2:23-25
 - b. Proverbs 5:15-20
 - c. Song of Songs 2:2-6
 - d. 1 Corinthians 7:3-5, 8-9
- 4. What impact has culture had on your view of sex?
- 5. If God created sex, why is it the source of so much confusion, pain and conflict?
- 6. What causes a couple to lose passion for each other? What steps can be taken to recapture the passion?
- 7. If marriage is a picture of Christ and the church (Ephesians 5:22-32), how is physical intimacy a part of that picture? How does pornography distort that picture?

- 8. Why does God reserve sex for marriage? See <u>Proverbs 5:15-20;</u> Song of Songs 2:7; 3:5; 8:4; 1 Corinthians 7:1-2; <u>Hebrews 13:4.</u>
- 9. Why is it important for Christians (single and married) to talk about and understand God's design for sex?

- 11. What are ways we can honor God with our body?
- 12. How can a person find healing from sexual sin?
