Discussion Guide

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

COMMUNICATE WITH GOD

- 1. Read <u>John 10:1-5</u>. What can you do to hear God's voice more clearly throughout each day? How do you listen for Him?
- 2. Read <u>John 15:1-8</u>. What practical steps can you take to *remain in God*?
- 3. Write down and discuss several things that are true from John 15:1-8.
- 4. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-15. Summarize what Paul is teaching in vs. 7.
- 5. What are we communicating to God when we give our time and money to the work of the church? See also Proverbs 3:9-10; Hebrews 13:15-16.

CONNECT WITH CHRISTIANS

- 6. According to these passages, what should be common practice for believers? Who will you grow with in these areas?
 - a. Romans 15:5-7
 - b. 1 Thessalonians 5:11
 - c. <u>James 5:16</u>
- 7. Read <u>John 17:21-23</u>. What can you do to help Brookwood move closer to *perfect unity? See also*: Acts 2:42-47; Colossians 2:2; 3:12-17.

CARE FOR OTHERS

- 8. Read <u>Proverbs 19:17</u> and <u>Matthew 25:40</u>. What does it mean when we give to the poor, we are really giving to God?
- 9. What are some of your favorite ways to care for others?
- 10. What are some of the biggest challenges you face when it comes to pursuing a more personal, ongoing relationship with Jesus? What steps will you take to overcome these obstacles?

Soul Training

Pause for several minutes and focus your mind on Jesus. Ask Him to quiet your heart. Express thanksgiving and love to God, and ask Him to deepen your love for others.
