Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read Colossians 3:1-4.

- 1. These opening verses include beautiful and foundational truths for followers of Jesus. But what do you think each of the following statements really mean?
 - a. You have been raised to new life with Christ.
 - b. Your real life is hidden with Christ.
 - c. You will share in all His glory. See also <u>1 John 3:2</u>.
- 2. Why is it so important to set our hearts and minds on the realities of heaven (vs. 1-2)? In very practical terms, what does this look like? See also: Matthew 6:19-24; Luke 12:13-34; and Philippians 3:12-14.

Read Colossians 3:5-11.

- 3. List several of the *sinful*, *earthly things* mentioned in this passage. What attitudes or actions in your life need to be *put to death* so you can focus more on the things of God and less on the things of this world? See also: Proverbs 23:1-5; 17-21; 1 John 2:15-16.
- 4. How do we *put to death* our sinful nature? How does Paul describe the transformation process? See also: Romans 8:5-11.
- 5. Reread <u>Colossians 1:9-12; 2:2-3; 3:9-10</u>. How does knowledge help us battle against the sins mentioned in <u>vs. 5-9</u>?

- 6. If your spouse or a close friend was asked to name ways they see you becoming more like Jesus, what would they say (vs. 10)?
- 7. The Bible doesn't speak about race, but about tribes and nations. Even though we all don't have the same skin color, we are all of *one blood* (Acts 17:26-28) and *one flesh* (1 Corinthians 15:39-40).
 - a. Do you feel that a particular racial, religious or ethnic group is inferior to you (vs. 11)?
 - b. How does the message of Christ honor the dignity of all people?
- 8. In a sentence or two, how would you summarize the main point of this week's teaching?
- 9. What's your biggest takeaway from this week's teaching?
