Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read Colossians 1:15-23.

- 1. What characteristics does Paul use to describe Jesus in verses 15-20?
- 2. How would you describe the relationship of Christ to God the Father based on these characteristics?
- 3. What one word or phrase is most significant to you in this description of Jesus Christ?
- 4. What is the role of Jesus in creation?
- 5. What is the role of Jesus in your reconciliation with God?
- 6. How would you summarize the point Paul is making in this description of Jesus?
- 7. How would you describe yourself when you were an *enemy of God*? (vs. 21)

- 8. How does it make you feel to know Jesus died for you and presents you to God as holy and without fault? (vs. 22)
- 9. What practice can you do this week to continue to remember the significance of Jesus' death for you?
- 10. What benefit do you experience when you acknowledge that Jesus is first in your life?
